	CACJ will pay for the lodging costs and training certification costs and reimburse the Employee ONLY for meals and mileage expenses while attending the <u>Interactive Journaling Training October 4-5, 2021</u> , as outlined in the			
	State Accounting Office (SAO) Policy and Procedure Handbook. CACJ provided meals are for the Employee ONLY.			
	The Employee should arrive on time and not leave training sessions early. Failure to do so may result in the			
	Employee's inability to obtain training certification. In the event the Employee fails to obtain training certification,			
	the accountability court judge and court coordinator will be notified by CACJ staff. Further, if the Employee fails to obtain training certification, the cost associated with the training certification is subject to de-obligation from the			
	court's state grant fund. It will be up to the court program to obtain reimbursement from the Employee.			
	Should the Employee no longer work with the court program within 24 months of gaining certification from			
	Interactive Journaling Training October 4-5, 2021, the employee should reimburse the court program for the fee			
	associated with the training certific
