DRUG COURT COUNSELOR – Treatment Services

SUMMARY OF DUTIES:

This position is responsible for clinical counseling and monitoring participants in the Drug Court Program. The incumbent maintains a caseload and performs all the duties and responsibilities of a Drug Court Counselor, gives treatment recommendations to the Treatment Court Team, requires the ability to conduct evening counseling groups, and reports directly to the Program Coordinator.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED:

Bachelor's or Master's Degree in a related field. Incumbent must be credentialed Certified Addictions Counselor I or II, Licensed Professional Counselor, Licensed Clinical Social Worker or hold an associate's level license in professional counseling or social work. Experiential requirement includes three years in the substance abuse and/or mental health field. Must be familiar with HIPAA and Federal Confidentiality Rule 42 CFR regulations. Must be detail-oriented and work well under pressure. Experience in working with the criminal justice population, counseling/case management is necessary. Incumbent must be able to work in a fast-paced, deadline-driven environment of the courts under limited supervision.
